Sub: **Categorization as Bulk Waste Generator for implementing provision of SWM Rules 2016**

Sir

The Group Housing Societies of Dwarka are in receipt of INDIVIDUAL NOTICE TO BULK WASTE GENERATOR. The Societies have been directed to furnish self declaration form that the society produce less than 100 Kg. waste per day, in their premises, and if more than 100Kg. waste is found generated during verification it can be categorized as Bulk Generator and can be imposed penal charges as applicable.


It is to inform you that the SWM Rules 2016 were notified in supersession of Municipal Solid Waste (Management and Handling) Rule 2000. The point 8 under heading DEFINITIONS of waste generator as per SWM Rule 2016, issued by Min of Environment, forest and climate change reads as " ... and includes Building occupied by the Central Govt. department , Local bodies, Public Sector Undertaking or Private Companies, Hospital Nursing Homes , School, Colleges, Universities, other educational institutions, Hostel, Hotels, Commercial Establishment, Market places , Places MOF Worships Stadia, Sport Complexes having an average waste generation not exceeding 100 Kg. Per Day."

It can be seen that the definition of Waste Generators does not include residential areas. As such the cooperative housing societies can not be brought under the category of Bulk Waste Generator.

Further,(as per point 7) it is also informed that gated communities and institutions with more than 500 sq.mtr. area shall within one year from the date of notification of these rules , with partnership of local bodies , ensure segregation of waste at source by generators as prescribed in the rules.

In view of the facts explained above the residential societies can not be categorized as Bulk Waste Generator and the notice issued to the societies may please be withdrawn.
